# BIG ARTS SUMMER ARTS CAMP RULES 2017

Please go over these camp rules with your child. If any of these rules are not followed, the discipline policy will be reinforced. Thank you!

- No running allowed on the BIG ARTS campus
- Campers must be with an instructor or volunteer at all times
- Please keep your hands to yourself
- The “Garden” is off limits (unless with an instructor)
- Please make sure that the bathroom doors are closed when you leave
- Please be respectful to adults, volunteers, and other campers
- No Electronics Allowed - including I-Pods, cellphones, hand held games, etc. Please leave at home or with lunchbox once camp starts at 9:00 AM.

## Summer Camp Discipline Policy

To maintain good discipline, our youth program places great emphasis on positive relationships between the children, staff and parents. There are three levels of disciplinary action. The level will be determined by how serious the act is or frequency of the act or both. Policy is as follows:

### Level I

1<sup>st</sup> offense of the day: the child will be reminded of the rule he or she broke

2<sup>nd</sup> offense of the day: the child will sit out and lose 20-40 minutes of participation

### Level II

Isolate the child in office area away from program activity.

Call parents notifying them of behavior and the necessity to pick the child up from the program and/or request assistance with the disciplinary process.

### Level III

We are unable to tolerate excessive disciplinary problems in our programs. Your child will not be permitted to attend for the following reasons:

- Refusal to follow program policies (insubordination, etc.)
- If child inflicts harm on another child, causing injury
- Stealing
- Destruction of BIG ARTS property

For BIG ARTS Summer Arts Camp, priority will be given to campers enrolled in the Fine Arts Apprentice program (½ day class, ½ day volunteer). Fine Arts Apprentice campers will be assigned accordingly based on experience and on a first come first serve basis.

Summer Arts Camp volunteers will assist the 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> campers with program activities and provide supervision during and in between classes, assist camp instructors with class set-up/clean-up, and provide administrative/office assistance. **Please note that due to the high volume of volunteer applicants we receive, volunteer hours are only offered for half the camp day.
