

Supply List for Full-Day Resin Workshop with Tammy DeCaro

Resin, pigments, paint and canvases are supplied. We will have a lunch break; plan accordingly.

1. Dress appropriately – resin is messy and does NOT come out of clothes.
2. Supply fee – cash, check, Venmo or Zelle pay at class. See registration for supply-fee amount.
3. Wear comfortable shoes – this technique is usually created standing up.
4. Bring a heat gun and extension cord. A heat gun is a specialty item that can be found in hardware stores or on Amazon. Any heat gun will work, but the resin moves better if the heat is variable, and the flow is directed using a concentrator nozzle.

5. Bring an extension cord for the heat gun.
6. Gloves – I provide large-size gloves – if you need a different size, bring lots of them!
7. Shells – if you have shells to add to your beach resin piece, please bring them!
8. If you have taken other fluid-art classes with me, feel free to bring one of your fully dry canvases to learn how to seal a coat with resin. You can also bring other art – but make sure it is acrylic paint without silicone or oils. Dry/finished canvas under 16x20”.
