Recommend Cheap Joe's Prime Really Good Lightfast Acrylic Paint, Liquitex, or Golden Acrylic
Light Blue Violet
Light Blue
Brilliant Purple
Hooker's Green Deep Hue Permanent #225
(when opened...it appears black..... available in Liquitex)
Pthalo Green
Pthalo Blue
Raw Sienna
Alizarin Crimson
Naples Yellow
Cadmium Yellow Light & Medium
Cadmium Red Light
Titanium White
Burnt Sienna

Brushes

1-inch Flat Angle Brush
Small Assorted Rounds
1/2-inch Flat Angle Brush
...and of course, bring along your favorites!

Note: I recommend Princeton Dakota series 6300 1" angle & 1/2" angle #12 & #6

Also

Masterson Stay Wet Palette (including both sponge and paper) rags, coffee can, small bucket, or container (for water) spray/mist bottle.

Canvases

16" x 20" or larger (2 per day)
It would be helpful to Prime your canvases with red or orange before class.

Remember, of course, to always wear OLD CLOTHS or AN APRON...AND COME WITH A POSITIVE ATTITUDE – EXPECT TO HAVE FUN!!
