

Student Supply List: Beginning & Intermediate Watercolor class with Sunny Krchmar.

Brushes: 2 round, #6 round, Flat 1-inch, fan brush (any size)

Paint: Mungyo Professional ½ pan set 12 color set. You may get a larger set if interested.

Paper: 140 lb. cold press watercolor paper pad (24 sheets for 4-week class 10 sheets for 2-day class) approximately 9" x 12"

OR Spiral watercolor notebook with 140 watercolor paper

Other:

Plastic cup/bowl for water

Fine tipped pencil for drawing

1 roll of paper towels

1 fine tipped black archival/permanent marker (Sharpie brand or equivalent)

1 small package or shaker of salt

Masking or painters tape

1 sponge

Crayons: variety of colors but especially white

Paint palette with lid or ceramic plate to mix colors on

Please feel free to substitute any items with what you may already have or different brands.

Windsor Newton & Mungyo paints are highly suggested for best quality and easiest to manage. If you plan to continue with watercolor they are worth the investment.

Additional items you may want to bring, but not required: watercolor pencils, watercolor markers, exacto-knife, cling wrap, any additional paint colors or brushes you may already own.
