

## Watercolor & Collage Supply List with Cheryl Fausel

### Day 1:

- For the Collage part bring a selection of papers, napkins and images or magazines to cut out images from.
- Bring scissors – with a sharp point to have control over what you are cutting out.
- Bring supports for your collage...watercolor paper is fine...A black background is interesting.
- The size of your paper (supports should be a few 7" x 7" and 8" x 8").
- A glue stick is helpful for tacking down your pieces. I will have matt medium for the final gluing.

### Day 2:

- **Paper:** Watercolor paper ¼ sheet squared...11" by 11" (a ¼ sheet of watercolor paper) ... Archers 140 lb. Cold Press is the paper I paint on.
- **Paints:** You will need a palette with a variety of paints ready to paint, (preferably tube paints already loaded onto your palette (you have a better quality of paint)
- **Pencil:** a lead pencil, I use a mechanical pencil
- **Brushes:** assorted brushes
- **Masking Tape:** I use Nitto tape which can be bought on Amazon...at least 1" to 2" in width, can be wider, or Ace's painters' tape, cream colored, a snap cutter knife...9mm (the small one)
- **Container** for water at least two or one with 3 compartments (a student caddy is great) and paper towels. *BIG ARTS has paper towels and plastic water containers on hand.*
