Enjoy this fun-filled evening as we begin in the classroom learning about Raku, a traditional Japanese pottery-firing technique. Tim & Dana will guide students through the enjoyable process of glazing a pre-thrown pot. Offering a different glazing technique for each class. *See class curriculum link below for details.*

Students will observe the exciting steps of loading and unloading the kilns outside in the sculpture garden while sipping on wine and enjoying light snacks during the 45-minute firing process. Finally, the pots are quenched with water before each student takes home their beautiful one-of-a-kind Raku work of art.
