Designed for students with basic hand-building experience, this class deepens your understanding of techniques such as coil, slab, and pinch construction. You'll focus on improving form, structure, and surface design while incorporating decorative elements like carving, stamping, and glazing. Students will work on guided projects such as lidded vessels, sculptural forms, or functional ware, with increasing creative freedom.

Prerequisite: Completion of a beginner pottery class or equivalent experience

Skills Developed:

- Refining construction techniques
- Adding texture and decorative surfaces
- Advanced glaze theory and application
